RESIDENTS AT LOWER McLAUGHLIN LAKE TO VOLUNTARILY EVACUTE

Hoke County Emergency Management has advised that the Kaco dam near the McLaughlin Lake area will likely overflow its banks due to Tropical Storm Florence.

Residents in this area are encouraged to **VOLUNTARILY EVACUTE** from this area. Levels are expected to exceed those seen with Hurricane Matthew.

Now is the time to take shelter. The shelters at Don Steed, Sandy Grove, and West Hoke have space for residents. If you feel you are in need of relocation, take action now.
