HOKE COUNTY CLOSSES SHELTER LOCATION

Officials have announced that the shelter located at West Hoke Middle School will be closing by 1pm today. We will be relocating residents to the following location:

Hoke County Officials urge all citizens to either take shelter at a County Shelter or to be prepared to be self-sufficient for 72 hours following the storm. Residents are to remain indoors between the hours of 7:00 pm and 7:00 am starting on Wednesday, September 12th at 7:00 pm.

All persons coming to a shelter are asked to bring bedding, medicines, foods (especially baby foods and baby supplies), personal hygiene items, and flashlights. Firearms and alcoholic beverages are forbidden; law enforcement will retain the right to search bags brought into the shelter as a safety precaution. Do NOT bring frozen food to the shelter. Those persons who depend on home oxygen (or other medical resources contingent on access to electrical power) should make arrangements to have an adequate additional supply on hand.

Transportation to the shelters, particularly for the elderly and disabled, is available on an as needed basis through Hoke Area Transportation, **unless worsening weather conditions necessitate that such services cease**. Those with transportation needs should call 910-848-4646 and ask for the Transportation Coordinator.

Animals are not allowed at general population shelters. For those going to a shelter and needing emergency pet sheltering for dogs or cats, pet sheltering is offered. The pet shelter will have cages, food and water. You must provide leashes and any medication needed for your animal. All pets must be picked up from the pet shelter when you leave the general population shelter.
